Predeparture Details for: Glacier Walk

All guests going our Glacier Walk will start at **900am** from our Whistler Village location: "The Nordic Shop" across from the Telus Conference Centre. We ask that you meet us **15 minutes** prior to trip departure. Upon arrival, all guests will be required to sign a liability waiver. Youths under 19 years of age will require the signature of a parent or guardian.

You will depart from the Village and take a short walk up to the Blackcomb base, where you will take the chair lifts up to the top of Blackcomb Mountain. From the top of the chair lift, there is a short walk to the glacier. From July 27th until October 1st, transportation to the glacier will be via four wheel drive vehicle. The average summer temperature in the Alpine is 5°C/42°F, and you will be exposed to the elements. **All guests are expected to have a minimum fitness level, able to hike for 2 hours up hill.** Trip duration will be 4-5 hours. You will be outfitted and provided with the following equipment for the Glacier Walk:

What's provided:

Boots, Gaiters, Crampons
Ice axe, Harness, Helmet
Gloves, Jacket, Backpack
Fleece jacket, Rain Pants, Tuques
Water & Snack
Ground Transportation

What to bring:

- Summer jacket
- Long sleeved shirt
- Fleece/wool sweater
- Non-cotton pants (jeans not recommended), nylon/polyester pants are recommended
- Camera
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
